### 1- KFAR DEBIAN Region "Dairy & Mounne"

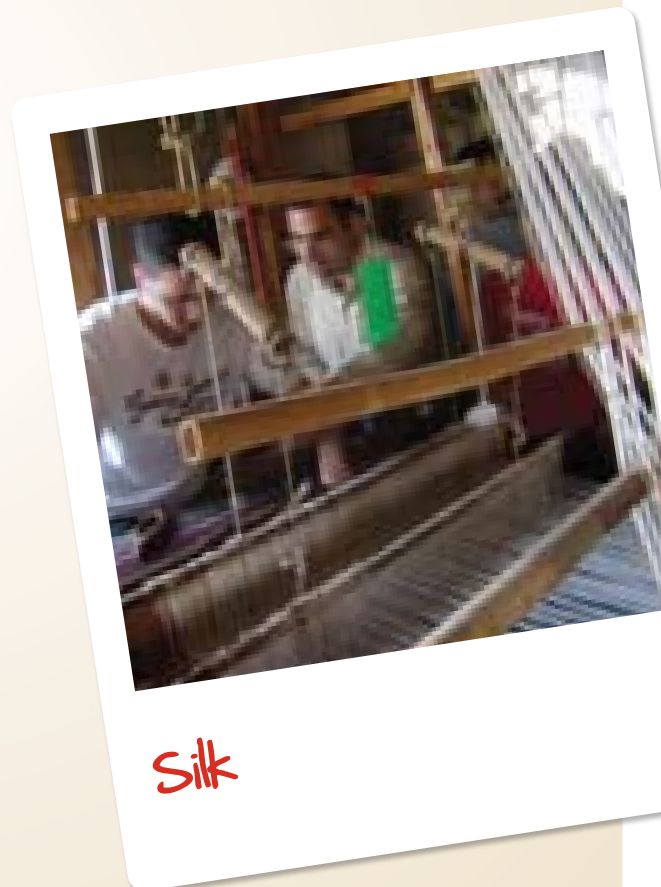
Depart from Beirut north towards the Zouq. Start driving up the mountains east on the Feytroun road to Kfardebian; stop for breakfast at Feitroun at a local "Manakish" snack; easy hike in Kfardebian outskirts in a splendid rocks scenery; visit the **Fagra roman temples and Byzantine church** remain; typical lunch at Auberge Beity ; after lunch, visit an exceptional dairy products family farm, then visit the women food processing unit (possibility of buying dairy and provisions). Return to Beirut.

### 2- CHOUF Region "Silk & Mounne"

Depart from Beirut for Baadarane. Along the way, stop for breakfast in Deir el-Qamar; once in Baadarane, visit a Druze silk weaver in his workshop. Walk around the village and visit a Druze tomb and an old molasses press house. Typical lunch in a local house. After lunch, transfer to Bater and visit a food processing unit and learn about the seasonal "**Mounne**". Return to Beirut.
